## **Ongoing Improvements to Carnegie Avenue**

### *Temporary traffic pattern change at East 30<sup>th</sup> Street*

**CLEVELAND** – Improvements begin March 20, 2017, weather permitting, on the south side of Carnegie Avenue at East 30<sup>th</sup> Street and run east to East 32<sup>nd</sup> Street. As part of ongoing improvements and upgrades, [Dominion](#) is replacing an old steel mainline with a modern plastic version in the sidewalk area on Carnegie Avenue.

One lane of traffic (the curb lane) is impacted during construction. A work zone will be in place with traffic control personnel in the work zone directing traffic. Access to all adjacent driveways will be maintained.

Work will occur from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. The work zone will be removed on the eastbound lane(s) by 3 p.m. in consideration of outbound rush-hour traffic restrictions. If a work zone is required on the westbound side of Carnegie Avenue, the work zone will be active after 9 a.m. in consideration of inbound rush-hour traffic.

This project is scheduled for completion, including restoration, in May 2017.
