- **Personnel**
 - 28 Fulltime Drivers
 - 94 Seasonal Drivers
 - 122 Total Drivers**

- **In addition:**
 - 16 Seasonal --Municipal Service Laborers
 - 11 Seasonal—Municipal Construction Equipment Operators
 - 3 Seasonal ----Radio Operators
 - 30 Total Seasonal**

- **Equipment**
 - 71 – Snow Plow Vehicles
 - 15 – Pickup Trucks with Plows
 - 13 – Road Graders
 - 14 – Front End Loaders

January 11th:

2nd and 3rd Shift – 48 plows each

January 12th:

1st Shift (7 am to 3 pm)

- **48 Plows – pre salt hills and bridges**

2nd Shift (3 pm to 11 pm)

- **48 Plows – plow and salt Mains**

3rd Shift (11 pm to 7 am)

- **48 Plows – plow and salt Mains**

January 13th:

1st and 2nd Shifts – 48 plows each

***Other Units can be acquired through Parks Division and Public Utilities Department upon request, in a major snow event.

- **Materials Inventory (in tins)**
 - 9,263 – Rock Salt
 - 19,400 – Gallons of liquid De-Icer

- **Snow Removal Policy**
 - 54 - Primary Main Street Routes
 - 292- Residential Sub-Sections

- **Order of Snow Removal Service**
 - 1st – **Primary Main streets are serviced**
 - 2nd – **Residential Streets are serviced between 4-72hrs after storm has ended.**

(Depending on snow accumulations)

Snow Removal Time Frames

1-4 inches of Snow	4-8 hours - (Main Streets)	24-36 hours (Residential Streets)
4-6 inches of Snow	8-12 hours - (Main Streets)	36-48 hours (Residential Streets)
6 inches or above	8-16 hours-(Main Streets)	48-72 hours (Residential Streets)
