- **Snow Removal Policy**

54 – Primary Main Street Routes  
292 – Residential Sub-Sections

- **Order of Snow Removal Service**

1<sup>st</sup> – Primary Main streets are serviced  
2<sup>nd</sup> – Residential Streets are serviced between 4-72hrs after storm has ended.

*(Depending on snow accumulations)*

### Snow Removal Time Frames

1-4 inches of Snow	4-8 hours - (Main Streets)	24-36 hours (Residential Streets)
4-6 inches of Snow	8-12 hours - (Main Streets)	36-48 hours (Residential Streets)
6 inches or above	8-16 hours-(Main Streets)	48-72 hours (Residential Streets)

1 <sup>st</sup> Shift (7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.)
• 48 Plows – pre salt hills and bridges
2 <sup>nd</sup> Shift (3 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.)
• 48 Plows – plow and salt Mains
3 <sup>rd</sup> Shift (11 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.)
• 48 Plows – plow and salt Mains
