



Timeline of Steps Leading to Placarding of Non-Compliant Properties From 2003-2014 (Backlog)

2003-2014

- Referrals received from Ohio Department of Health
- Case manager sent information packet & letter to parent/guardian
- Questionnaire completed by case manager
- Onsite Public Health Lead Investigation - Investigation conducted
- Inspection report & Lead Hazard Control Orders (LHCO) were sent to owner
- Case manager continued to follow-up with family to monitor child's progress

June 2016

Held several community events and invited property owners and occupants of properties where Cleveland Department of Public Health issued LHCOs

October 2016

- Mailed letters to property owners and parents informing them of existing lead hazards
- Held several community events and invited property owners and occupants of properties where Cleveland Department of Public Health issued LHCOs

January- September 2017

All case files were reviewed to ensure current ownership and required documentation

May 2017

Mailed copy of existing LHCOs to property owners

October 2017

CDPH sent warning letter to family regarding outstanding LHCO and noncompliance

February 20, 2018

CDPH mailed copy of Notice of Non-Compliance and Order to Vacate - requiring occupants to vacate property with 14 days of receipt.

Week of April 2, 2018

CDPH placards property
