Application Information

Vendors interested in providing shared mobility services in the City of Cleveland must apply for a Shared Mobility Device and Bicycle Share Vendor Permit, as well as secure a [Bicycle and Scooter Share Vendor's License](#) from Cuyahoga County.

Application submissions and fee payments are due by Friday, July 26 at 5:00pm ET. Additional submission information is available in the Application Instructions.

An informational call for interested vendors will be held on Wednesday, July 17 at 4:30pm ET. To register for the call, email dockless@city.cleveland.oh.us.

The City of Cleveland anticipates issuing up to three permits for 2019-2020 to dockless scooter companies, and up to three permits for dockless bicycle companies, but reserves the right to issue fewer or more permits.

Application Steps for Potential Vendors

1 Read the Shared Mobility Permit Application Instructions + Rules & Regulations

2 Attend Cleveland's informational call for any further questions

3 Complete the Shared Mobility Permit Application

4 Submit the Shared Mobility Permit Application to the City via email, as well as paying the application fee, by July 26th

5 Ensure all requirements for the County license have been completed
