New Frederick Douglas Recreation Center Construction Begins March 2020

Ward 1 – 15401 Miles Avenue

New construction work as of March 2020

This work advisory will remain in place through 2021

CLEVELAND – The City of Cleveland will begin construction of a new recreation center located at Frederick Douglass Park at 15401 Miles Avenue. The new Frederick Douglas Recreation Center will include a full size gymnasium, large indoor pool and indoor children’s water play area, locker and changing rooms, community room, aerobics room, multi-purpose room, arts & crafts room, computer/instruction room, resource room, and tots room.

The exterior site improvements will include parking, green space, a new playground, and outdoor children’s splash pad. The existing gazebo, two tennis courts, and two baseball fields will be fully renovated.

Construction mobilization will occur in March 2020 and is scheduled to be complete by the end of 2021.
