Capital Repair work to begin Spring 2020
This work advisory will remain in place through July 2021

CLEVELAND – The City of Cleveland will be conducting capital repairs and improvements to the natatorium at Stella Walsh Recreation Center. This work includes replacement of the roof structure over the pool, including steel framing, decking, and roofing system; new lighting and HVAC distribution within the pool; new pool lining; pool deck repairs; masonry repairs; a state-of-the-art dehumidification system as well and high-performance barrier coatings on the structural members, improved insulation, which will minimize the possibility for condensation on the structure and will improve building energy performance.

Construction mobilization will occur in the Spring of 2020 and is scheduled to be complete by the end of July 2021.
