



2021 NFL DRAFT PROHIBITED ITEMS

In order to provide a safe environment and to expedite fan entry into the Draft Campus, security screening in and around the Campus will be significantly heightened for 2021 NFL Draft. All items carried by fans will be carefully inspected and potentially not permitted into the campus.

The NFL Draft is a smoke-free environment. The use of tobacco products and e-cigarettes is prohibited.

The NFL's clear bag policy will be in effect. Consistent with all NFL games, the NFL strongly encourages fans not to bring any type of bag to 2021 NFL Draft.

Permissible Bags

- Clear bags that do not exceed 12" x 12" x 6" and small clutch size purses not exceeding 4.5" x 6.5"
- Bags used for medically necessary items after thorough inspection at the entry screening site

Cleveland Division of Police List of Prohibited Items

- Alcohol
- Animals (except service animals)
- Any air rifle, air pistol, paintball gun, blasting caps, switchblade or automatic knife, knife having a blade two and one-half (2-1/2) inches in length or longer, cestus, billy, blackjack, sword, saber, hatchet, axe, slingshot, BB gun, pellet gun, wrist shot, blackjack, metal knuckles, num chucks, mace, iron buckle, axe handle, shovel, or other instrumentality used to cause property or personal damage;
- Any item determined by the Chief or Director to be a clear and present danger to the safety of others;
- Lumber larger than 2" in width and 1/3" thick, including supports for signs;
- Metal, plastic, or other hard material larger than 3/4" thick and 1/8" in wall thickness including pipe and tubing;
- Battery operated clothing (socks, jackets, etc.)
- Beach balls or inflatable devices
- Glass bottles, ornaments, light bulbs, ceramic vessels, and anything else frangible, regardless of whether the container holds any substance
- Non-plastic containers, bottles, cans, or thermoses
- Backpacks and bags exceeding the size of 18" x 13" x 7"
- Chairs, stools or any other seating devices
- Drones/Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) of any kind
- Fireworks and pyrotechnics of any kind
- Footballs, frisbees or throwing objects
- Illegal substances, drugs or drug paraphernalia
- Laser pointers
- Mace or pepper spray, or other chemical irritant
- Sound amplification equipment
- Poles, sticks, missile types objects of any kinds
- Seat cushions with pockets, zipper compartments or covers
- Selfie sticks or tripods
- Umbrellas larger than 48"
- Weapons of any kind

In addition, the NFL prohibits the following items:

- Banners, signs (any object that obstructs the view of others)
- Bottles, cans, thermoses, cups and beverage containers of any kind, unless purchased at an NFL venue or an empty, reusable water bottle
(plastic baby bottles are permitted if an infant is present)
- Binocular cases or camera bags
- Camcorders or video recorders, except for credentialed media
- Cameras with removable lenses more than 6”
- Noise makers, horns, whistles or musical instruments of any kind
- Outside Food
- Promotional items with commercial slogans or identifiers without written consent from the NFL

Note: Prohibited items and items determined to be inappropriate for entry into the secure perimeter will be the responsibility of the fan and cannot be accepted, stored or checked by the NFL or the Cleveland Police Department.

Reusable Water Bottles – Fans will be allowed to enter with an empty, reusable water bottle for filling within the perimeter.

The cooperation, patience and understanding of fans is greatly appreciated by the National Football League and the Cleveland Police Department.
