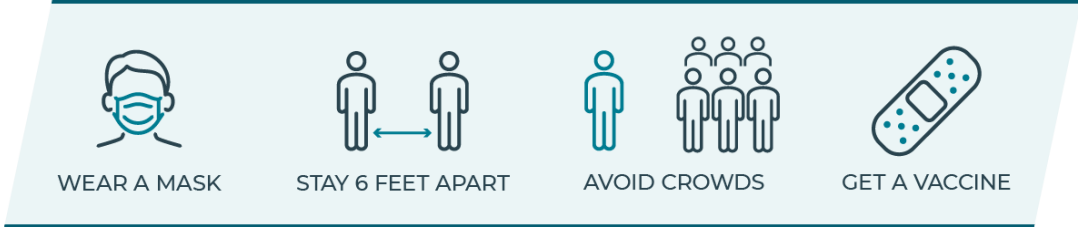

Cleveland COVID-19 Case Summary, April 11 – April 17, 2021



What Matters Most

1. The number of COVID-19 cases in Cleveland continues to rise for the fifth consecutive week (Fig. 1) reflecting a concerning national trend.
2. Hospitalizations are showing an increase compared to last reporting period, which is consistent with the increase in cases.
3. Thirty positive cases of the B.1.1.7 and 1 positive case of B.1.429 have been identified among Cleveland residents. Both variants have increased transmissibility and may contribute to the increase in cases seen in recent weeks.
4. CDPH has administered 54,584 first and second doses to more than 28,000 people. Nationally, over 130 million people in the United States have safely received a COVID-19 vaccine. Based on the increase in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations and the higher transmissibility of variant strains, receiving a vaccine remains an important and effective step in protecting yourself and your community against COVID-19.

* This report includes preliminary data obtained on April 20, 2021 for the Cleveland City ranging from the beginning of the pandemic through April 17, 2021. Data are subject to change over time. Cases and hospitalizations for this reporting week may increase in previous reporting weeks as more data becomes available. COVID-19-related deaths may take weeks to confirm.
* Cases include confirmed and probable COVID-19 cases. Variant cases are identified by the Ohio Department of Health through genomic sequencing of a random sampling of confirmed COVID-19-positive specimens.
* Vaccination summaries include only vaccines administered by CDPH and does not represent all of Cleveland City.



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Figure 1. COVID-19 Cases in Cleveland by Week

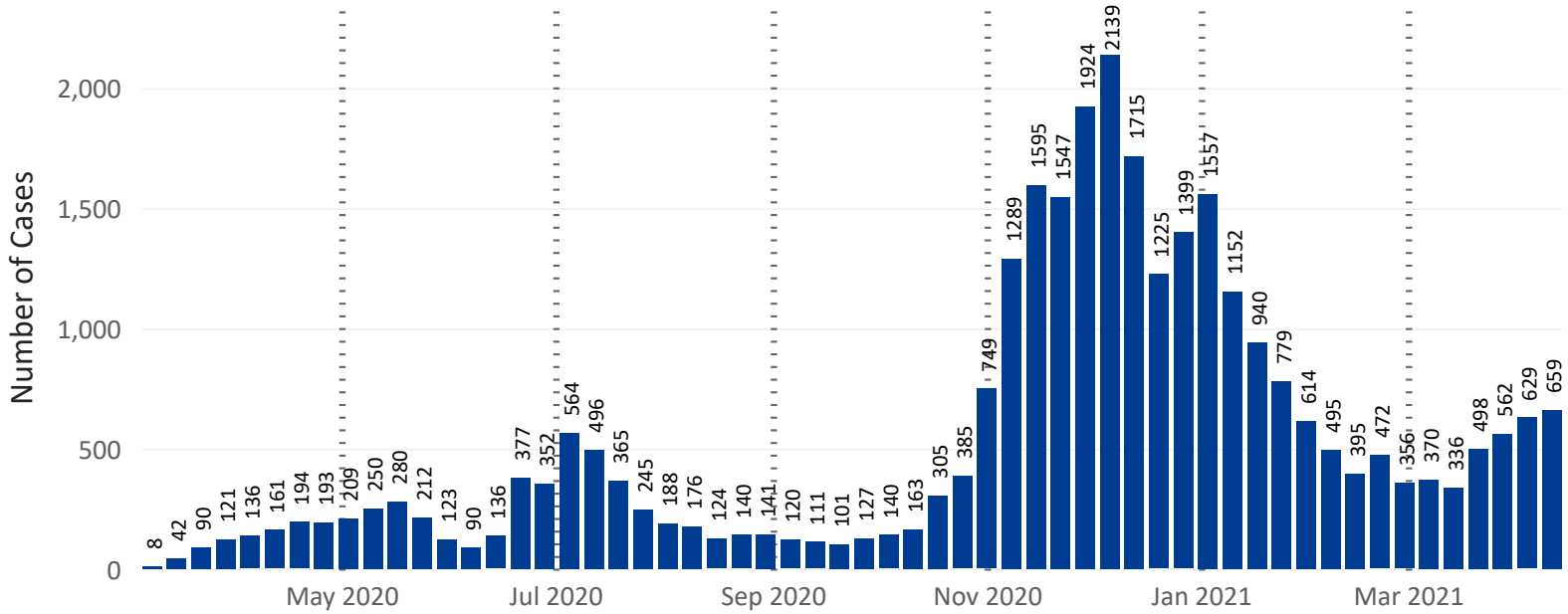
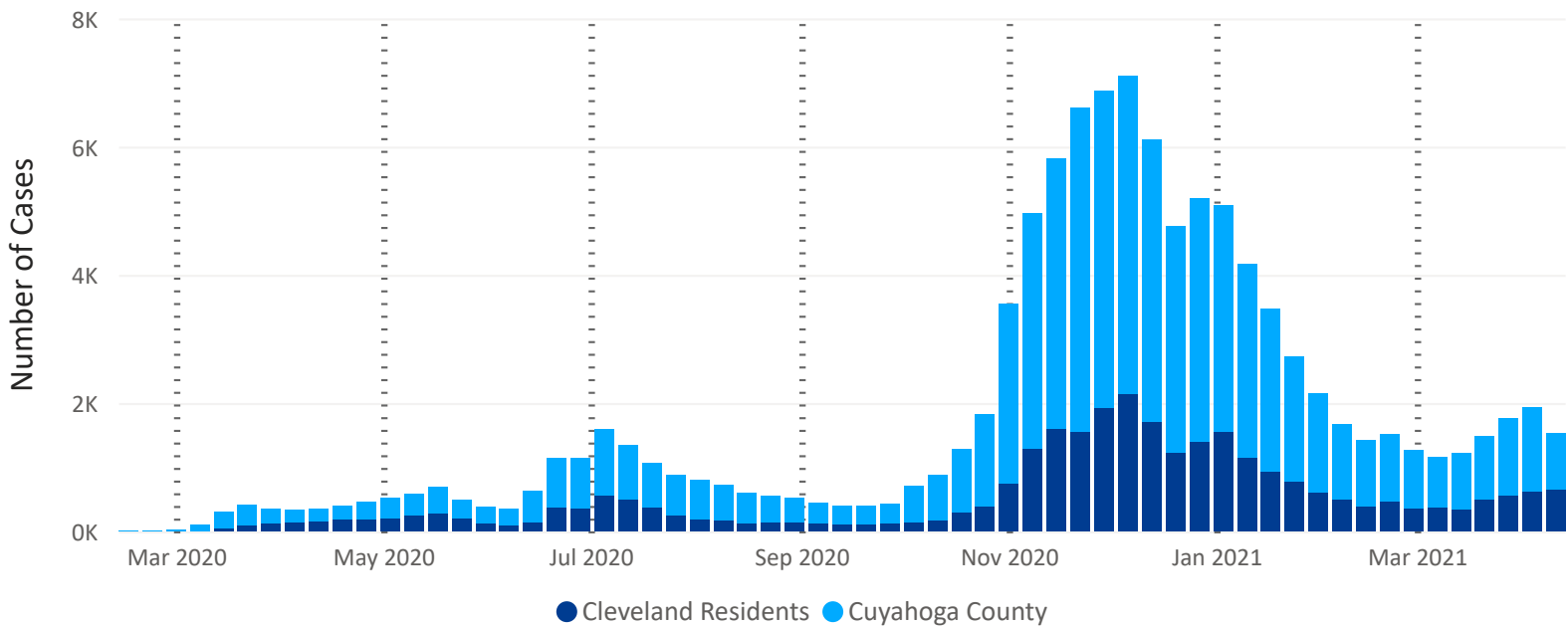


Figure 2. COVID-19 Cases in Cuyahoga County by Week



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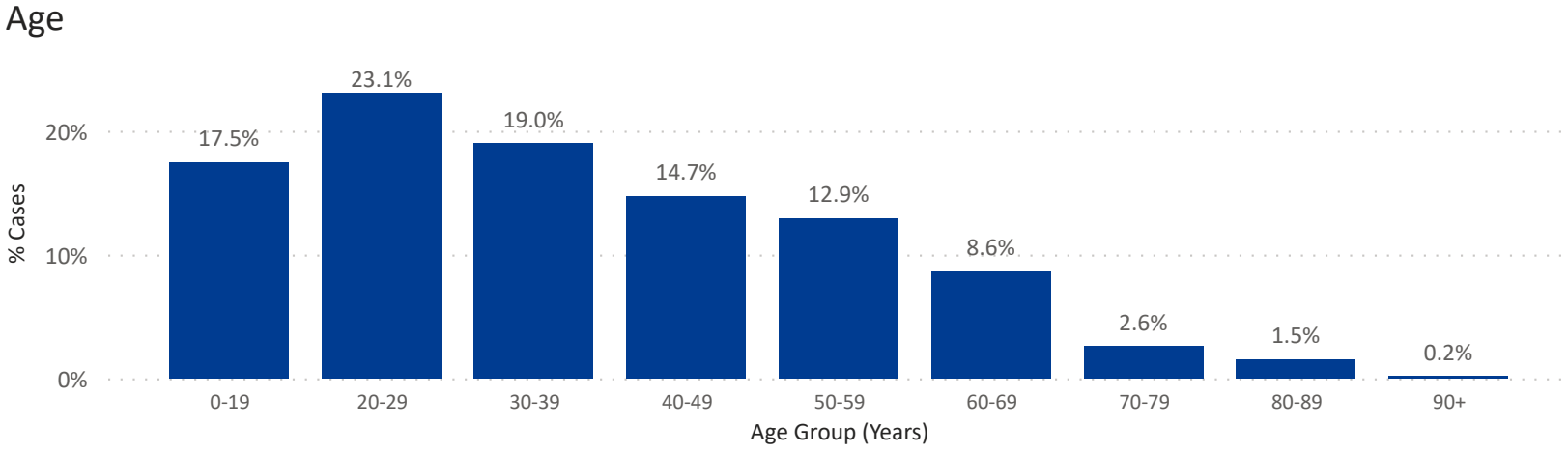
* Cases here are reported by specimen collection dates for COVID-19 diagnostic tests. If the specimen collection date is unknown, the earliest known date associated with a case is used.
* These figures do not include 18 cases with unavailable dates and cases reported prior to February 15.



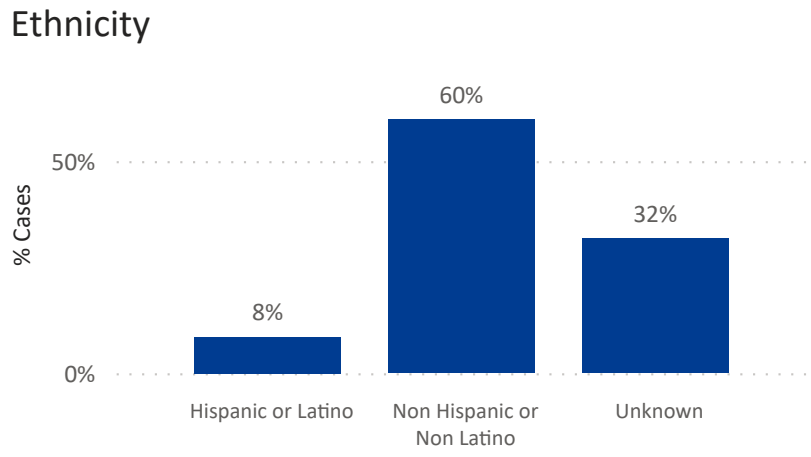
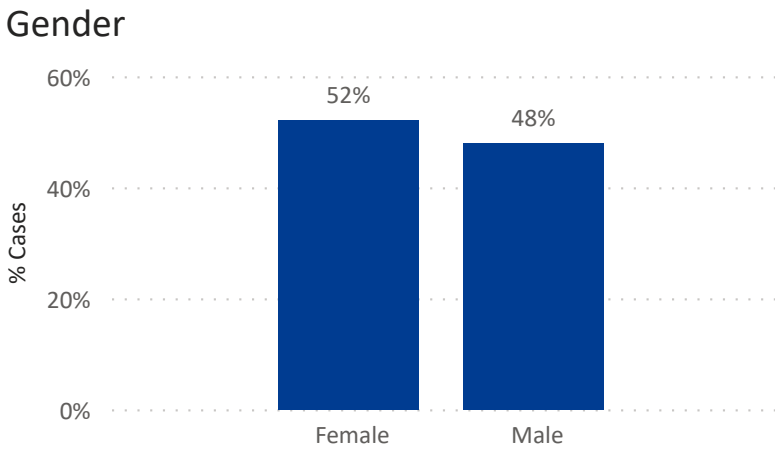
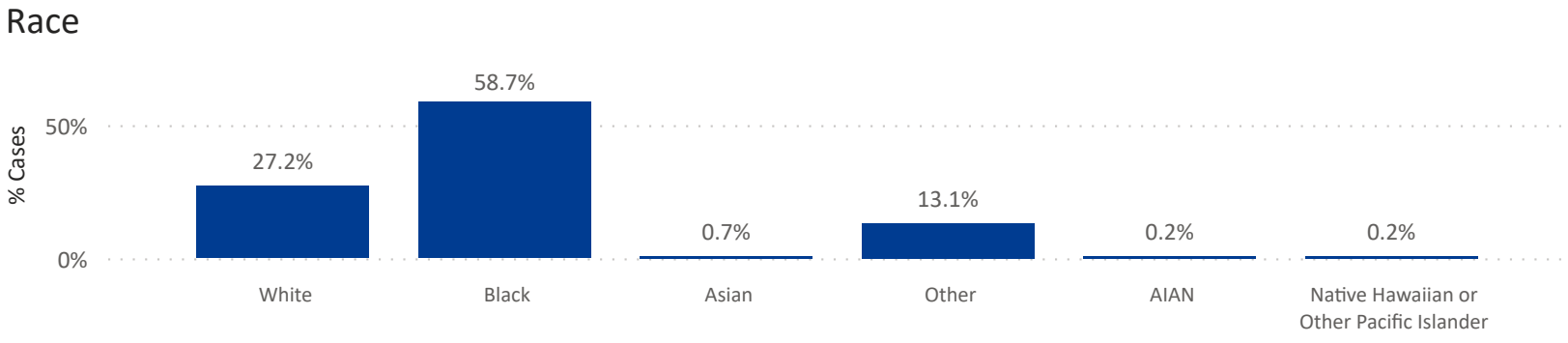

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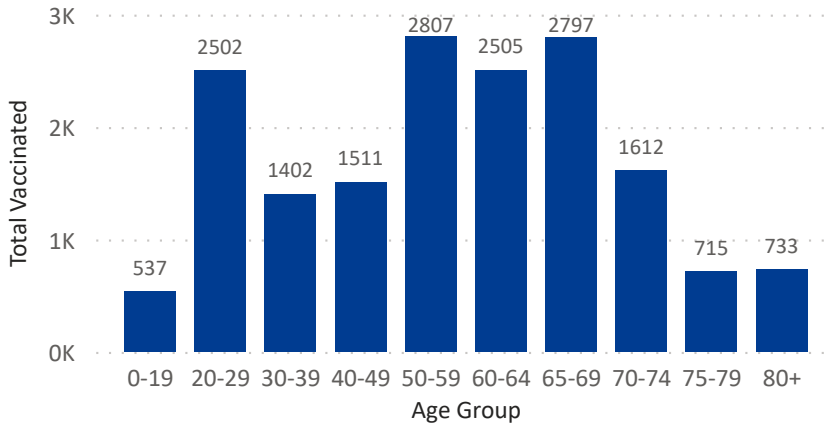

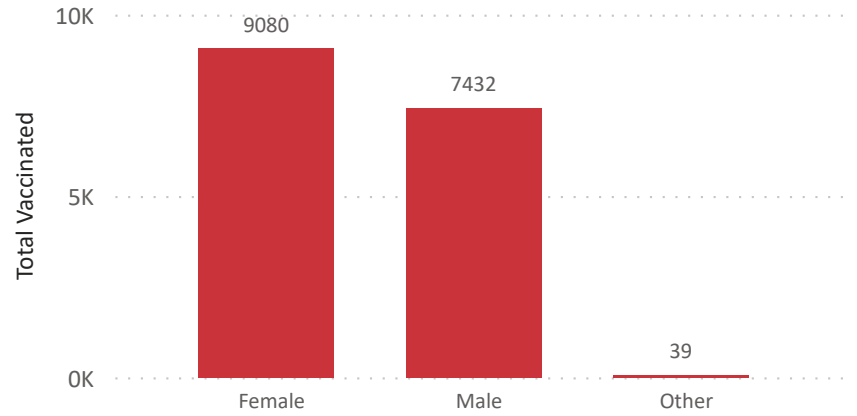

Demographics of Cleveland Residents Vaccinated by CDPH (N = 17,121)

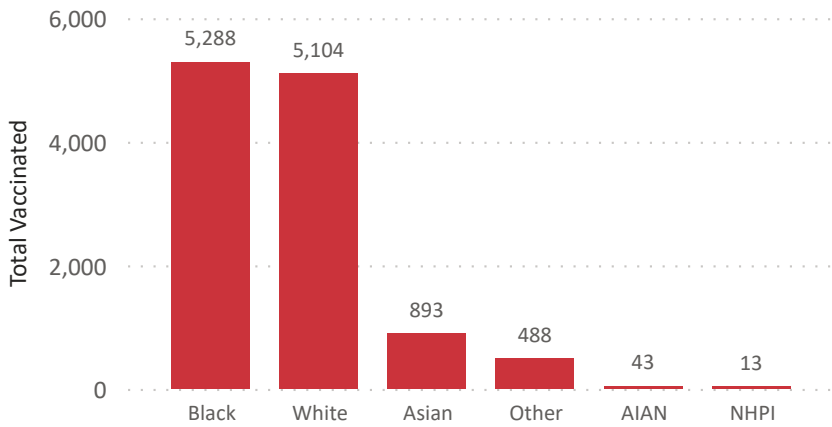

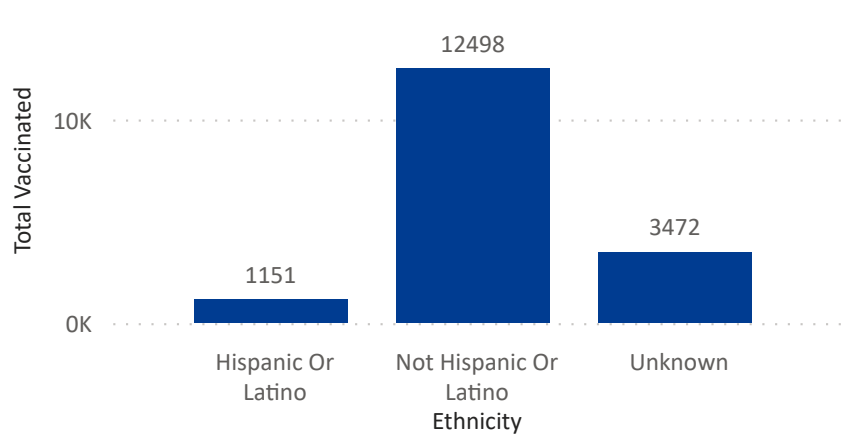
Gender
