

# CITY OF CLEVELAND CURBSIDE RECYCLING PROGRAM GUIDELINES





Below are the program guidelines for participating in the City of Cleveland's bi-weekly, opt-in curbside recycling program. All residents participating in the program are expected to follow these guidelines. Failure to do so may result in the removal of the blue recycling cart.

## Set Out Guidelines:

- Carts should be set out no earlier than noon the day before collection
- Carts should be removed no later than noon the day after collection
- Carts should be placed 2-3 feet apart with the metal bar facing the street
- Carts should not be marked, painted or otherwise altered by residents
- All material set out for recycling must be in the blue recycling cart (no materials are accepted outside of carts, with the exception of bulk and yard waste)
